A VIEW FROM THE PEW by Rachel Brophy

"He is risen!" "He is risen indeed!" This proclamation and response to it, followed by the echoing triumph of the hymn, "Jesus Christ is Risen Today," is the most concrete understanding of Easter that I have, and I am glad for this. Ever since I was too young to remember, my mother would march her two little girls dressed in Easter dresses newly sewn by their grandmother into church at 7 a.m. (Dad was Catholic, but don't worry, he wasn't sitting home. He just went to his own church). There was an air of anticipation in the sanctuary lit only by the rising sun. The tall wooden cross at the front of the sanctuary was covered in Easter lilies. When it was time for the service to begin, the lights were thrown on, and it was announced, "He is risen!" I would then hear my mother beside me, seeming much taller than her 5'4", saying with such confidence that you had to pay attention, "He is risen indeed!"

There was a time when I was younger, that my mother's bold confidence in her response caused for me that, "Aw Mom! Let's tone it down a bit and just blend in," sort of embarrassment that seems to plague kids as they approach their teenage years. I have since outgrown that affliction. These days I look forward to Easter morning and hearing those words, because I can hear my mother's voice just as clearly as when she stood next to me declaring, "He is Risen Indeed."

In our daily walk through life with Christ there are times when we have to dig deep to find our faith. When children are harmed or lives are taken at the hands of evil doers or natural disasters we often find ourselves on shaky ground wondering, "Why?" Each day with which we are blessed offers the opportunity to grow in our faith, but some days are harder than others to figure out how to make that happen.

On Easter we are given a gift that is much greater than anything left in a pastel-colored basket filled with plastic green grass. God gave us his only son, so that we might have eternal life. If that was not gift enough, on this special day his gift means even more. We can rejoice in the comfort of certainty. There is no question that we are saved, and this certainty can bring us great joy and strength in a world filled with challenges and changes.

My mother radiated joy on Easter morning that I have only come to truly appreciate in adulthood. This joy was a result of the gift of certainty that Christ's resurrection brings to an uncertain world. "He is risen!" "He is risen indeed!" These words spoken at the beginning of the Easter service are an announcement, a declaration. When it is announced, "He is risen," there is no question that this is anything but true. On this day, we are given the opportunity to celebrate the absolute certainty of our salvation.

Western Iowa Synod Assembly to be held at the Clay County Regional Event Center, Spencer, Iowa, on Friday, May 29 - Saturday, May 30. Vanessa Bremer, Phyllis Green and Jerry Wilde have expressed an interest in attending. Immanuel Church is allowed 2 voting representatives plus the pastor.
