"Spirit Sends Us Forth to Serve"

On Good Friday Jesus was crucified and three days later he rose from the dead on Easter. This fulfillment of God's promise means that as believers in Jesus Christ we are all saved by grace. We know this. If you're reading these words, then you picked up your newsletter and have likely been to church enough to know about our wondrous gift of salvation. What many may not know, however, is that this is hardly where the story ends. Fifty days after Easter, God fulfills another promise to his people by sending his Holy Spirit to the church. This is what we call Pentecost.

Pentecost is often called the "birthday of the church," because it was on this day that Peter preached his first sermon and roughly 3000 people joined the church. Before the day of Pentecost, there were believers, but the Christian church had yet to be "born."

Many of us can probably rattle off something intelligible about Pentecost being the story of when the Holy Spirit blew into a room and soon everyone had flames above their heads and was speaking in all sorts of random languages which no one learned, but they all understood. But do we really understand what this means for us today?

When Jesus died on the cross we were given eternal life. When God fulfilled his promise on Pentecost by sending the Holy Spirit we were given a voice to go forth and spread the good news of salvation through Jesus.

We are not required to do anything to achieve our salvation. That is bought and paid for through grace, but in filling us with the Holy Spirit, God gives us the tool we need to go out into the world and share his word, so that others may be saved just as we are.

Many of us may think, "But why me? I don't want to. I'm not good at that. I'm shy. People will laugh at me." It is no mystery that we Lutherans are not really into evangelizing. We do our thing, help others and try to be good people, but going out into the streets and preaching the Good News really hasn't been our style.

However, God wants us to do this, of course, so that others may hear the Good News and be saved, but also for what this experience does to enrich our own lives. In giving our lives over to speak the Lord's words and do the Lord's work, our lives are transformed into a thing so much better than we could have ever imagined. God wants our life here and now to be as rich as the next one, and the way to that experience is, as always, through him.

On the day of Pentecost the disciples were transformed into apostles. The believers were transformed into missionaries. God has given you the power by fulfilling his promise and filling you with the Holy Spirit. Go forth into this world on **your** mission and speak God's word with your tongue of fire.
